2014 BOWL GAME ANNOUNCES ROSTER FOR ANNUAL SHOWCASE

ROCKAWAY, NJ (October 11, 2013) – The biggest weekend in youth football returns to San Antonio's Alamodome. Much like the U.S. Army All-American Bowl, which has become the “can’t miss” game for football fans across the country looking for a preview of the nation’s top prep football talent, the Eastbay Youth All-American Bowl has become the biggest preview of the next generation of prep stars.

Jake Low (Virginia Beach, VA) has accepted his invitation to play Linebacker at the Eastbay Youth All-American Game and will have an official jersey presentation event at Ocean Lakes High School (VA) on October 11th, 2013 at approximately 6:45 PM. He will be honored before his teammates, classmates, fans and family prior to kickoff of the Ocean Lakes football game.

Several thousand youth athletes are nominated annually for this elite honor, but only a handful are selected by the Eastbay Youth All-American Bowl selection committee, which includes regional directors and scouts from Football University. Some past participants of the bowl game include Sony Michel, Tyrone Swoopes, and Brandon Dawkins.
